Course purpose:

The course in physiology provides students with the knowledge about:

- physiological processes within cells, tissues, organs, organ systems,
- interaction of multiple physiological systems,
- control mechanisms necessary for homeostasis of human body,
- adaptation of human organism to various changes in the inner and outer environment.

Upon completion of the course, a student of medicine will be able:

- to recognise normal function of cells, tissues, organs, and organ systems,
- to associate in an easy and rational way functions of multiple systems,
- to understand physiological integration functions of human body,
- to attend and learn the contents of clinical courses,
- to draw conclusions about organ system disorders out of anamnestical and lab patient information, and the impact of that disorder on other organ systems.

The knowledge acquired in the course is a key starting point in the understanding of normal functioning of human body and pathological mechanisms, and the ways they can be ameliorated or removed entirely.
